STIPULATION AND AGREED  
ORDER WITHDRAWING  
EMERGENCY ORDER

NOW on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of ~~March~~<sup>April</sup>, 2011, comes before the Kansas Dental Board the following stipulation, agreement and order. The parties hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. On or about March 7, 2011, the investigating member of the Board issued an Emergency Order limiting Dr. Wisdom’s Kansas Dental license in the following respects:

“A. Respondent is prohibited from beginning to treat any new orthodontic cases; and

B. Respondent is prohibited from removing tooth enamel from a tooth of any current patient for the purpose of making room for a band as part of orthodontic treatment.”

2. Dr. Wisdom denies the allegation that he removes tooth enamel for the purpose of making room for orthodontic bands.

3. Dr. Wisdom initiated an action under the Kansas Judicial Review Act in a matter styled as *Eric J. Wisdom, DDS vs. Kansas Dental Board*, Shawnee County District Court Case No. 11 C 326. Dr. Wisdom also filed a motion asking the Court for an immediate stay of the

Emergency Order.

4. The parties agree that if Dr. Wisdom does not remove tooth enamel from a tooth of any patient for the purpose of making room for a band as part of orthodontic treatment there is no need for the Emergency Order.

5. Dr. Wisdom maintains that he does not and further stipulates and agrees that he will not remove tooth enamel from a tooth of any patient for the purpose of making room for a band as part of orthodontic treatment.

6. Based upon Dr. Wisdom's assurance and agreement with the Board's representative as provide for in the preceding paragraph, the Board's representative determines that the Emergency Order can be withdrawn.

7. The parties agree that if the Emergency Order is withdrawn, the above-referenced proceeding in Shawnee County District Court is not necessary.

WHEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. By his signature appearing below, Dr. Wisdom affirms, under penalty of perjury, that he will not remove tooth enamel from a tooth of any patient for the purpose of making room for a band as part of orthodontic treatment.


2. By the authorized signature appearing below, the investigating Board member withdraws the Emergency Order dated March 7, 2011.

3. Upon signature of the investigating Board member or his designee, this Stipulation and Agreed Order Withdrawing Emergency Order shall become the Order of the Board.



County District Court.


