ORDER OF COMPLETION

KANSAS DENTAL BOARD

1. The Kansas Dental Board ("Board") issued a Stipulation and Consent Order on February 11, 2011 ("Consent Order").

2. Among other requirements in the Consent Order, Ronald E. Gier, D.D.S. ("Respondent") agreed and consented, and the Board found and concluded, that the following disposition was just and appropriate under the circumstances:

A. LICENSE RESTRICTION. Respondent agrees, and the Board further orders the Respondent's license is restricted in that he shall not perform endodontic treatment on any tooth with multiple canals until further order of the Board.

B. ADMINISTRATIVE FINE. Respondent agrees, and the Board further orders the Respondent, to pay to the Board, within ten (10) days of the effective date to the Stipulation and Consent Order contemplated hereby, an administrative fine in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000).


3. At its regularly scheduled public meeting on May 6, 2011, the Board considered Respondent's request to remove the license restriction. The Board held that Respondent would need to successfully complete the following to remove the license restriction: (a) The United States Navy Dental Course Titled "Endodontics," Course Number NAVEDTRA 13151-B, for 48 hours of continuing education credits; and (b) the endodontic portion of a regional clinical examination.

4. As required, the Respondent has submitted documentation verifying satisfactory completion of the following: (a) The United States Navy Dental Course Titled "Endodontics," Course Number NAVEDTRA 13151-B, for 48 hours of continuing education credits; and (b) the endodontic portion of a regional clinical examination from Central Regional Dental Testing Service, Inc. A true and correct copy of the documentation is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

5. The Respondent further timely paid the administrative fine in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) to the Board.

6. Accordingly, the Respondent has completed all requirements of the Kansas Dental Board's Stipulation and Consent Order dated February 11, 2011, and the case has been closed.


